Directions:

From I-40 east: Take exit 270 for US-15/US-501 toward Chapel Hill/Durham (turn left at top of ramp). After four lights, take left fork onto Fordham Blvd/U.S. 15-501 bypass (right at fork is Franklin Street). Turn right at second light onto S. Elliott Rd. *Extraordinary Ventures* is on the left just before State Employees Credit Union.

From Chapel Hill: From the center of town heading east on E. Franklin, turn right onto S. Elliott Rd (Whole Foods is at this intersection). *Extraordinary Ventures* is on the right 0.1 mile from the intersection, just beyond the State Employees Credit Union.
